



Statement of compliance

It is certified that:

- > The Rules governing the Public Sector Superannuation (PSS) Scheme, and amendments to them, comply with the requirements of the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993* and Regulations made under that Act.
- > Members may apply for benefits on cessation of membership however certain preservation conditions may apply in accordance with current government legislation.
- > The Rules allow benefits to be transferred to the Fund. There is no minimum amount that may be accepted into the PSS. The transfer amount available in respect of the member is acceptable if it is:
 - > an amount payable from an occupational superannuation scheme (providing it did not become payable due to physical or mental incapacity);
 - or
 - > an eligible termination payment;
 - or
 - > an amount payable in accordance with the *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992*.
- > Transfer amounts are not subjected to penalties or fees however unfunded components will be taxed in accordance with the taxation legislation.
- > Members cannot borrow from the fund.
- > ComSuper is the Administrator of the Public Sector Superannuation Scheme.
