Good news – completing your income tax return will soon be easier

In line with the Treasurer's Budget announcement, ARIA and its administrator, ComSuper, have been working with the Tax Office to 'pre-fill' superannuation pension information in your electronic tax return.

What is pre-filling?

Pre-filling is a service which is being provided by the Tax Office to make it easier for you to meet your tax obligations and claim your entitlements. Pre-filling is when your tax return is partially completed for you and all you have to do is review it, ensure that it is correct and where necessary add missing details.

What does this mean for you?

From August 2007, if you use the Tax Office's electronic tax return lodgement system (e-tax) to prepare and lodge your income tax return online, your superannuation pension information will already be included. You will not need to manually input the information.

If you use paper income tax returns or lodge your return through a tax agent, you will still need to use your pension payment summary to complete your tax return.

If you received a lump sum in the 2006/07 financial year, this information will not be pre-filled. The pre-filling service may extend to this in the future.
